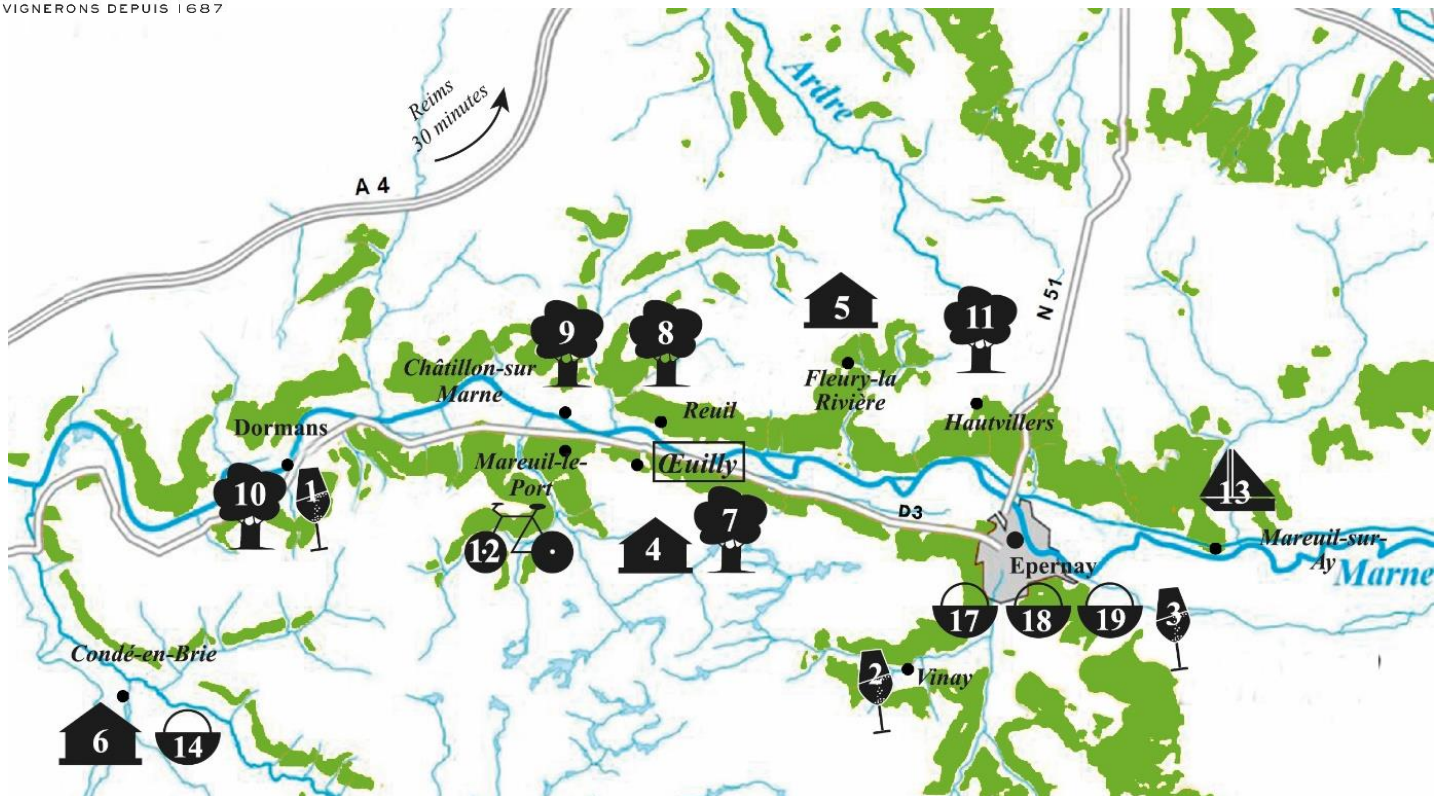

From Tarlant's house, we are often intrigued by a high point in the landscape. It is a sculpture of Pope Urban II, born in Châtillon-sur-Marne in 1040. There, a viewpoint indicator enables visitors to embrace the whole Marne Valley and its 22 villages.
